



Declaration of conformity **ROHS REACH**

ROHS - Restriction of Hazardous Substances

The European Directive RoHS 2011/65/CE limits the quantity of 6 Hazardous Substances considered dangerous for humans and for the environment used in the new electrical and electronic equipments.

Those substances are:

Piombo (0,1 %) Mercurio (0,1 %) Cadmio (0,01 %) Cromo esavalente (0,1 %) Bifenili polibromurati (PBB) (0,1 %) Eteri di difenile polibromurato (PBDE) (0,1 %) Ftalato di bis(2-etilesile) (DEHP) (0,1 %) Benzilbutilftalato (BBP) (0,1 %) Dibutilftalato (DBP) (0,1 %) Diisobutilftalato (DIBP) (0,1 %).

Our Technical Staff together with our Purchasing Department perform analysis and continue an accurate and steady monitoring on our whole production and transformation cycle. Some traces of the substances listed may be present as impurities in the raw materials used by us but they are not added intentionally.

Notwithstanding that the products comply with the RoHS Directive, the responsibility inherent in the equipment falling within the scope of the directive in question lies solely with the manufacturer of such equipment.

REACH – Registrazione, Valutazione, Autorizzazione e Restrizione delle sostanze Chimiche
Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals

The European Regulation REACH entered into force on 1 June 2007 to standardize and improve the structure of chemicals legislation within the European Union.

Brero Engineering Srl has revised the requirements of REACH and analyzed its impact on the production of their products and, according to the definitions provided, the company is recognized as the "end user of chemicals."

We pursue all the obligations and objectives of REACH and declare that no SVHC (Substance of Very High Concern) is present in items we produce following last update on attachment XVII of regulation (CE) n.1907/2006.
